

Introduction to Exhibition Space

The Setagaya Art Museum is located in Tokyo's Setagaya region, inside Kinuta Park. Established in 1986, the building is designed by architect Shōzō Uchii, who focused on a design which integrates the building into the park's natural environment. The museum holds the Permanent Collection Galleries, Special Exhibition Galleries, and the Citizens' Galleries. It's a cultural space that combines art, nature, and daily life, displaying a variety of works from masters to local Japanese artists.
